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




Therefore, many people felt that the birth anniversary of most of the great men should not be celebrated in SVERI today.

Student Visit to Kasegaon Gram Panchayat Contour Survey (Soil and Water Conservation Survey.)





Introduction:

The Department of Civil Engineering organized an extension activity for S.Y. B.Tech Civil Engineering students and faculty focused on conducting a road survey at Kasegaon Gram Panchayat on 04th November 2023. The purpose of this activity was to assess the condition of roads within the village and propose recommendations for improvement.

Objective: The primary objectives of the road survey were:

- To evaluate the existing road infrastructure, including pavement condition, signage, and drainage systems.
- To identify areas requiring maintenance or repair to ensure safe and efficient transportation.
- To engage students and faculty in practical fieldwork, fostering experiential learning and community involvement.

Survey Highlights:

The survey team, comprising faculty members and students, conducted a comprehensive assessment of roads throughout Kasegaon Gram Panchayat.

The survey team utilized advanced DGPS equipment to collect highly accurate positioning data along designated road segments within Kasegaon Gram Panchayat. DGPS technology enabled real-time correction of satellite signals, ensuring centimeter-level accuracy in position measurements.

Data acquisition included road surface profiles, cross-sectional dimensions, and geospatial coordinates of key features such as intersections, bridges, and culverts.



Concurrent use of Geographic Information System (GIS) software facilitated seamless integration of survey data for comprehensive analysis and visualization.

Various parameters were evaluated, including road surface condition, potholes, road markings, signage, and drainage.

Observations were recorded using standardized survey forms, supplemented by photographic documentation to capture key findings.

The team interacted with local residents and authorities to gather insights into community concerns and prioritize areas for improvement.

Findings and Recommendations: Based on the survey findings, the following key observations and recommendations were made:

Several roads exhibited signs of deterioration, including potholes, cracks, and uneven pavement, compromising road safety and usability.

Inadequate signage and road markings were identified as contributing factors to traffic congestion and confusion among road users. It was recommended to prioritize road maintenance activities, such as patching, resurfacing, and installation of road signs and safety barriers, to enhance overall road conditions. Collaboration with local authorities and community stakeholders was suggested to facilitate the implementation of proposed improvements and ensure sustainability.

Conclusion:

The extension activity proved to be a valuable learning experience for students and faculty, providing hands-on exposure to real-world challenges in civil engineering. By conducting a thorough road survey and proposing practical recommendations, the Department of Civil Engineering aims to contribute towards enhancing transportation infrastructure and promoting community welfare in Kasegaon Gram Panchayat.
