Barrier Free Built Environment for Disabled and Elderly Persons

The college has provided required facilities which make college barrier free for physically disabled and elderly persons. Following are the facilities provided by the college.

a) Ramp and Rails

The Institute has an entrance accessible to the handicapped and it is indicated by signage. In college ramp is built at the south-west corner entrance as shown in the building plan and it is designed as per the norms provided in a design manual for the barrier free environment in universities/colleges.
